9. Along with the Value system, he also discussed various researches showing the level of stress, depression, heart diseases etc... among people due to the lifestyle **creating “Value Crisis”**.
10. He also emphasised everyone in elaborating & knowing themselves: **“Who Am I”** where normally everyone fails to write & speak over a minute.
11. He talked about the education system & relation among **Teacher, Parent & a student elaborating the “Crisis at Teaching Level”**
12. Also with a great example Dr. Mishra elaborated that there is also a **Beauty Parlour** for the Teacher such as Reading Journal, Research, Google, and Innovation in teaching which **“Beautifies” their skill (knowledge)**.

The session was concluded with a Solution for “Value Crisis” as **Shiksha(Skill) & Vidya(Value) &** also instilling human values among students where teacher plays a more significant role than anyone else & also Dr. Mishra quoted **“Revisit your Thinking; Love your Work & the best would come out automatically”**
14. The program ended by **HIGH TEA & a video on Great Leaders & Legends**.
